### **GUIDELINES FOR INSTANT ARTS CLASSROOM FUNDS**

The Instant Arts Classroom Program is ready to work with Adams County teachers to integrate the fine arts into their curriculum! The program awards up to \$150 per teacher, per school year to bring in teaching artists to classrooms for workshops.

#### Application Guidelines:

1. Requests will be accepted up to a maximum \$150 for one art-in-education activity with a museum, cultural arts event, or to host a visual artist to teach an art lesson in the classroom. Fees for teachers are not covered.
2. There will be no phone calls to apply for funds.
3. Applications will be accepted through September 16, 2022.
4. Grants are considered on a first-come, first-serve basis and teachers will be notified if their grants have been accepted.
5. Teachers are required to arrangement dates and fees with the fine arts provider before submitting the request form.
6. Funds requested will be sent to the school prior to the event planned.
7. Funds are distributed at the discretion of Arts Quincy.
8. If more than one application by a teacher is submitted, additional grants will be distributed based upon fund availability.
